**TRINITY'S TABLE  
SUNDAY, April 22, 2012**

It was a cold and rainy day in Charleston, but in spite of this we had a great day at Trinity's Table. We fed a lot of hungry people tonight. We ended serving 273 meals. The menu was a hodgepodge of things: beef tips in gravy over noodles (60 lbs of beef bought from Food Bank at .19 cents a pound), green beans (bought at Sam's), carrots (bought at Sam's), Deviled Eggs (eggs donated by Food Bank), Pizza (donated by Food Bank), Summer Sausage (Sausage from Food Bank), desserts (donated by Food Bank, cookies, pies, donuts, cakes, you name it, we had it), tea/juice.

We had a lot of folks this evening. At one time the Social Hall was almost full. Still seeing a lot of new faces. We had a great group of volunteers today. Several to help prepare the meal some of which Eunice and I started yesterday and then we had TYG come in to help serve the meal. Over all it was a good day at Trinity's Table. We had enough help, enough food and plenty of people to eat it. It doesn't get much better than this. I want to Thank Amy Swan for applying and receiving from books for World Book Night. Amy applied and received numerous books which we gave out free to our guests. This was awesome that Amy took the time and effort to apply for this program for the guests at Trinity's Table. This program was designed to make books available to people who might not have the resources to purchase books. The books were all on the New York Times Best Seller list. The people enjoyed receiving these books. Again, Thanks a bunch, Amy for remembering the guests at Trinity's Table and all your efforts in making this happen.

The meal tonight cost us 39 cents per meal. Year to date we have served 4451 meals. There is definitely no shortage of people in need. Thanks to all our volunteers who help make Trinity's Table happen.

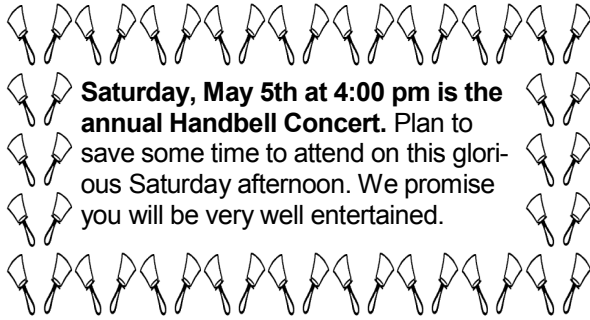
