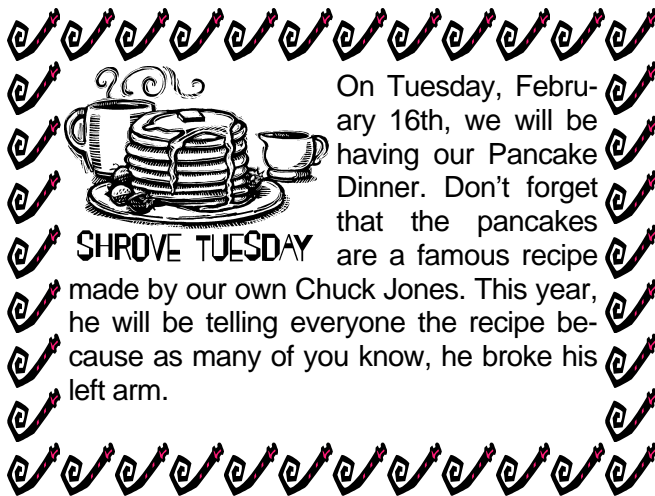
This week TYG left sub sandwiches for us to serve. Thank you for that. We added soup and the meal was complete.

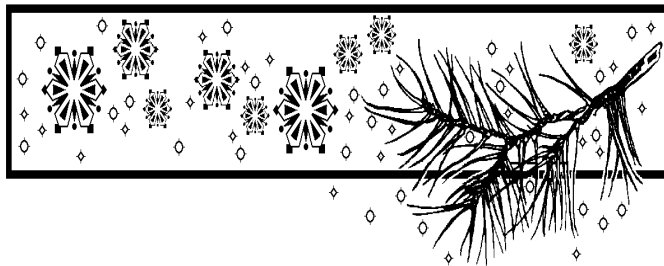
